The Facts:

The Parish rooms, were built 150 years ago and have served variously as a school (its original purpose), an Army Command Post during the war and finally were purchased by the PCC of St Albright's in 1954. Over the years the building has served the church and community well but by the early 1990's it was obvious that a major refurbishment or rebuild was necessary.

Since then various schemes were proposed but just over two years ago the PCC took the decision that it was now or never, and after prayerfully committing the project to God went ahead in faith. Building has now commenced and is due for completion in April 2010.

We plan to open St Andrew's Hall on Sunday May 2nd and from that date it will be available not only for church activities but for the use of the community at large. We envisage that small community groups or individuals will use the hall for regular or occasional meetings.
